### The Current Problem


Bowls are a common tool to separate out food and the clock method is used

340,000 people are registered blind or partially sighted in the UK.

There is **limited** existing support around eating food - even though you do it at least 3 times a day.

The problem is the person who is blind needs **assistance** knowing where and what is in front of them.

Headphones can be connected.


Hand gestures in-front of the plate

## The Product




The product is designed to be taken anywhere - home, restaurant, cafe...
